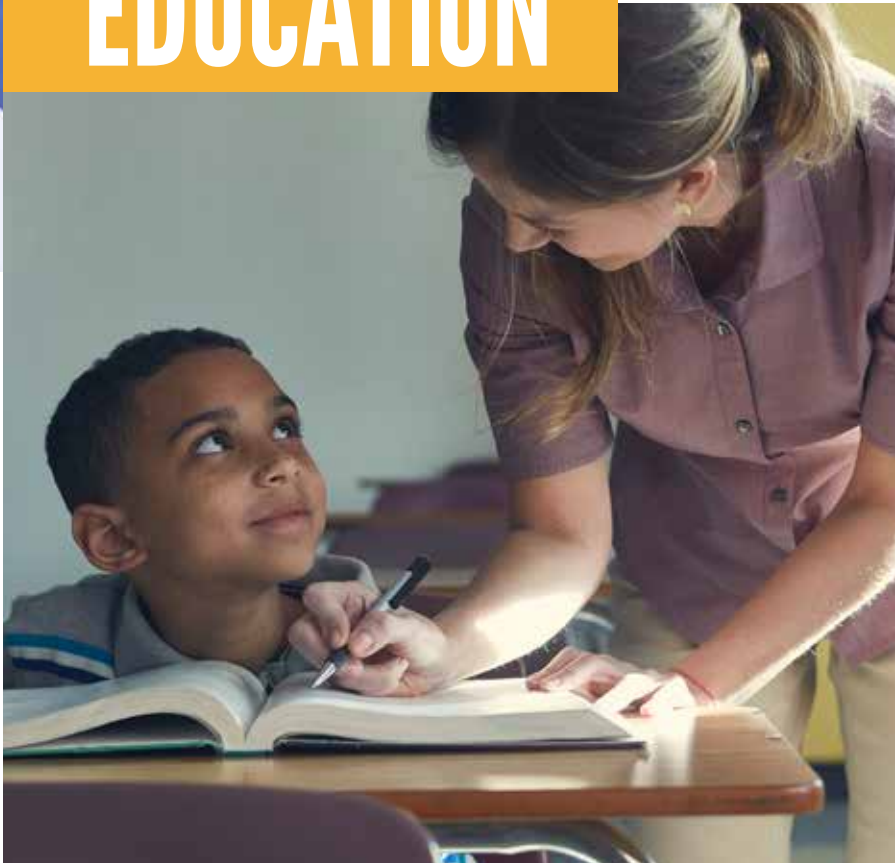
United Way invests in programs that improve individual and family health, safety and security.
